



Paediatric colonoscopy (Colon (P))

Key performance indicator (KPI) definitions

Stage 1 will be available as soon as a JETS user is set to 'training' in paediatric colonoscopy. The next stage will only become available when all requirements are met in stage 1. This is also true of stage 2 and 3.

All stages, including the 'overall criteria' and 'evidence' sections must be achieved to move to the summative assessment.

Criteria	Requirement
1. Total lifetime procedure count	≥150 (up to 30 of which can be flexible sigmoidoscopy in stage 1)

3. 50 (up to 30 of which can be flexible sigmoidoscopy in stage 1)	≥50 (up to 30 of which can be flexible sigmoidoscopy procedures)

For organisations who have gone through or are going through the NEDi2 validation process, procedures will only count if they have been validated by the trainee.

Any procedures added in stage 1 above 50 will automatically be counted at stage 2 when opened.

All must be paediatric colonoscopy DOPS and must be completed on procedures with one of the following extents:

- Terminal ileum
- Caecum
- Ascending
- Hepatic flexure
- Transverse
- Neo-terminal ileum
- Ileo-colon anastomosis

Any DOPS added at this stage that meet the extent requirements of stage 2 will automatically be counted when stage 2 is opened.

No item within the DOPS form can be rated 'maximum' or 'significant' supervision.

DOPS must be to terminal ileal or caecal extents to count towards the six DOPS requirement.

Caveat

9 out of the total 10 formative and summative DOPS should achieve caecal and ileal intubation; if less than 5/6 of the 'final assessment'/stage 3 formative DOPS have caecal and ileal intubation achieved, the candidate will not be able to move onto summative DOPS.
